ACT/SAT Workshops (grades 9-12):

Test Prep workshops will increase the student's knowledge of the academic material covered on college admissions tests and develop the critical thinking, reading, and test-taking skills needed to achieve higher scores. Additionally, guest speakers from various colleges and universities may be available to offer additional insights and instruction. **Daily homework will be assigned.** All students must purchase and bring to class a copy of **David McCullough's *John Adams***. This excellent biography will provide the additional reading support we require for the students in our program. An additional summer reading list will be provided as well.

Where are the Academic Enrichment Camps & Sessions held? All workshops are held at the **Academic Coaching Center at 8375 W Flamingo Rd, Suite 101 [In the JULIET Bldg. near Cimarron/DMV]**. The Center provides a comfortable educational environment with technological and research materials available.

What is the maximum enrollment for each workshop? Each test-prep camp is strictly limited to 8 students to ensure individualized attention and academic progress. Early enrollment is strongly encouraged.

Each **ACT/PSAT** workshop costs **\$1250** per student; workshop fees include study materials and workbooks. Multi-student discounts available for families. **Tutoring costs: \$50-75** per hour depending on the total number of hours requested.
